

## The STIB chooses BSB and CFObelux for the implementation of the SAP BPC application

The STIB has chosen BSB and CFObelux to implement the SAP BPC module (BusinessObjects Planning and Consolidation). This new application will make it possible to harmonise and to centralise the whole budget process of the Société des Transports Intercommunaux de Bruxelles (STIB).

The system currently used by the STIB does not meet its needs any longer. It has therefore decided to find and set up a new application primarily to improve its operational efficiency, facilitate budgetary consolidation and have its users benefit from better ergonomics.

The choice is the SAP BPC module, in line with the STIB's ICT strategy.

This application will enable the STIB to manage the budgetary consolidation strategy through a unified solution integrated into SAP Business Warehouse and a familiar and customised interface.

All the while allowing for genuine user autonomy, the implementation of SAP BPC will nevertheless enable the STIB to maintain the possibility to specifically develop the BPC module at a later stage.

To implement this new system, which is due to be rolled out at the end of 2010, the STIB has chosen to work with BSB. This is thanks to its experience in the trade, its comprehension of the problems specific to the STIB business and also its strategic partnership with the CFObelux company. Furthermore, SAP BPC also made its expertise in business and technical skills available, and hence BSB was able to convince the STIB.



The STIB is the number one Belgian urban transport company, and circulates in the 19 municipalities of the Brussels-Capital Region as well as in 11 other surrounding municipalities. It serves a surface of 241.5 km<sup>2</sup> and meets the transport needs of a population of over 1.1 million inhabitants. The STIB network includes 4 metro lines, 19 tram lines 50 bus lines and 11 night bus lines. In 2009, the STIB transported 290.6 million passengers and turned over EUR 207 million. The company employs 6500 people (FTE).
